

# Peace Projects Summary Proposal Evaluation Criteria

## Peacebuilding Relevance

10 points

- Does the project articulate a conflict resolution and peacebuilding focus?
- or
- Does the project relate itself to a peacebuilding and conflict resolution agenda? Does it have a peacebuilding aspect?

## Creativity & Novelty

10 points

- Does the project offer a creative solution to the stated problem?
- Does the project touch upon a rarely recognized problem/issue?
- Does the project offer a methodology that has never been tried before?

## Urgency of the Project

10 points

- Does the project address an urgent issue to be solved -i.e. a humanitarian crisis, an ongoing violent conflict?
- Does it reach out to hard-to-access and/or vulnerable groups/regions?

## Description and Significance of the Project

20 points

- Does the “Description and Significance of the Project” section of the proposal provide an overview of the project and proposed activities?
- Does the project display a solid understanding of the causes and dynamics of the particular conflict?
- Does the proposal clearly connect the understanding of the causes and dynamics of the conflict to the significance of the project?
- Does the project link its significance to similar or related works carried out previously?
- Does it identify where the project will take place, who the key stakeholders and the target groups are?

## Project Goals and Activities

25 points

- Does the project identify or state the goals of the project clearly?
- Does it clearly describe the proposed activities?
- Do the proposed activities address the causes and dynamics of the conflict described in the previous section?
- Are the proposed activities feasible? (Possible cultural, political, socio-economic, and temporal constraints, etc.)
- Is there a strong description of the proposed methodology?

## Theory of Change

25 points

- Does the project clearly articulate the relationship between proposed activities and expected change?
- Does the project clearly state how the proposed project activities will affect the beneficiaries?
- Does the project clearly indicate the expected outputs and/or outcomes of the project?
